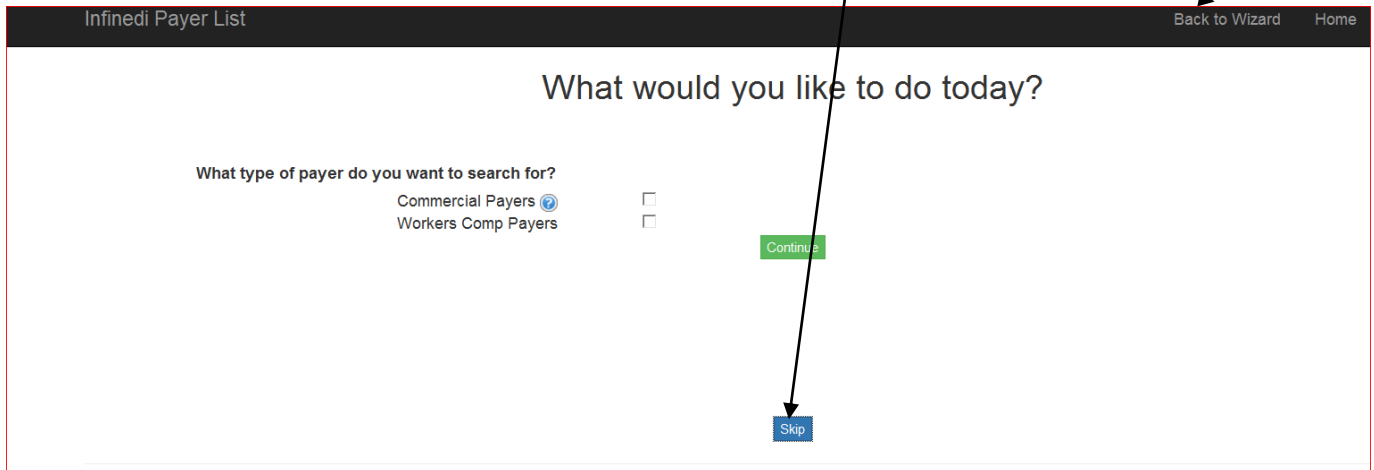


New! Payer ID List User Instructions

Infinedi has released a new version of our [website](#) that includes a new payer list located under the **Payer Search** tab on our homepage.



The new payer list offers many different ways to search, sort or filter the information to help make your job easier. You may choose our **guided search wizard** to find what you need or you may want to **skip** right to the payer search tool.



The wizard will ask you a **series of questions** about the payer to help narrow down your search results.

This new payer list will provide more details and information specific to proper routing of claims to both Commercial and Workers Comp (*also, Personal Injury and Auto*) payers. Our payer list may contain payers more than once. This is to insure that you have the option to route your claim to Workers Comp (*with or without attachment*) or to a Commercial payer. (*Keep in mind the fee structure is different for claims with attachments. Please contact Infindi for more information*) Infindi would also like to remind our providers to use Infindi payer IDs only. This will insure claims are routed to the intended payer. The payer list is updated daily. Please check back often to make sure you are submitting claims with the correct payer IDs..

Traditionally, Infindi has always matched on payer name and address for purposes of claims routing. Infindi now matches on Payer ID.

Providers Submitting Claims in Print Image Format

Example:

Submit payer ID from our payer list or Submit payer name followed by a space or forward slash and the payer ID.

Print Image claims addressed via either of these methods will match on Payer ID



Both above methods of addressing print image claims will route claim to correct payer.

***Print image claims addressed via this method will match on payer name & rather than payer ID and may not route to the intended payer ***

Clients Submitting Claims in ANSI 837 Format

Include the payer ID from our list in Loop 2010BB and Segment NM109.

Payer address is not required on ANSI claims as long as the payer ID is in the correct Loop/Segment. The only exception to this rule is Worker's Comp, PI & Auto claims. All Worker's Comp, PI and Auto claims must contain a payer address or claims will reject.

Please make appropriate changes to payer ids and or payer names in your Practice Management to match our new payer list.
