

TRICARE Region Changes

TRICARE has recently reorganized their regions. Infindi continues to process TRICARE claims electronically. Providers requiring new agreements will be contacted by Infindi. A small disruption in sending may occur during the agreement process when waiting for an approval from TRICARE. If contacted by Infindi for a new agreement please respond in a timely manner.

West Region:

On October 1, 2004, TRICARE converted the former Central region --- Arizona, Colorado, Idaho, Kansas, Minnesota, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, Nevada, New Mexico, North Dakota, South Dakota, Utah, and Wyoming – to be part of the new TRICARE West region. This transition will not change TRICARE benefits and costs.

North Region:

On July 1, 2004, TRICARE converted former Regions 2 and 5 to be part of the new TRICARE North region. On September 1, 2004, the former Region 1 (Northeast: Vermont, Rhode Island, Pennsylvania, New York, New Jersey, New Hampshire, Massachusetts, Maryland, Maine, the District of Columbia, Delaware, Connecticut, Northern Virginia and some zip code areas in Iowa, Missouri, and Tennessee) also joined the new North region.

South Region:

On August 1, 2004, TRICARE converted the former Region 3 and 4, which includes Florida, Georgia, South Carolina, Alabama, Mississippi, and Tennessee, to be part of the new TRICARE South region.

Region 6:

On November 1, 2004 TRICARE will convert Texas, Oklahoma, Kansas, and Louisiana to be part of the South region.
